

## **Small Hole Beads on Leather Look**

Professional Tip: Always test the drape of your piece before finishing.
It shouldn't be too loose or too tight.

## **Rubber Tubing**

This flexible tubing can be strung in between beads that don't fit onto leather.

- A. Cut sections of Rubber Tubing (looks like black 2mm Greek Leather but it's hollow).
- B. String Soft Touch© through a section of tubing, then a bead or pattern of beads, then another section of tubing, then repeat until you get the look you want.
- C. When you are ready to finish, string on a 3mm bead. This will prevent your crimp from going into the rubber tubing. Crimp ends to clasp as you would for any other necklace on Soft Touch©.
- D. Optional: To hide your crimps use crimp covers.
