Small Hole Beads on Leather Look

Professional Tip: Always test the drape of your piece before finishing.
It shouldn't be too loose or too tight.

Rubber Tubing

This flexible tubing can be strung in between beads that don't fit onto leather.

- Cut sections of Rubber Tubing (looks like black 2mm Greek Leather but it's hollow).
- String Soft Touch® through a section of tubing, then a bead or pattern of beads, then another section of tubing, then repeat until you get the look you want.
- When you are ready to finish, string on a 3mm bead. This will prevent your crimp from going into the rubber tubing. Crimp ends to clasp as you would for any other necklace on Soft Touch®.
- Optional: To hide your crimps use crimp covers.
